It is safe for women and girls 5 and up to receive the COVID vaccine.

Women can receive the COVID vaccine...

At any time during pregnancy



If they are trying to get pregnant now or in the future



While breastfeeding



If they are using birth control



If you have questions, consult with your medical provider.

Attention

If you are due for your mammogram, it is recommended that you get it before being vaccinated or waiting four to six weeks after getting your COVID-19 vaccine.



Reminder:

it is important to continue your routine screenings for cholesterol, blood pressure, blood sugar, mammograms, PAP smears, and other screenings.
